- Managing the work log and workload in the separations department

- Working with external studios
- Handing out designs and layouts to artists and explaining the technical specifications for the work, ensuring that the correct repeat sizes are used depending on the chosen print method
- Reviewing the designs worked by the separation's artists and feeding back comments and alterations to designs
- Communicating with the customers and coordinating meetings when required to discuss latest collections and designs
- Working cohesively within a large and varied department where clear communication and teamwork are key
- Working closely with the design manager to meet the expected timings on separation completion
- Producing design layouts and high-quality colour separations from customer's artwork to their specifications, for the purpose of conventional and digital textile printing
- Keeping detailed and clear notes to ensure a comprehensive history for all work undertaken
- Maintaining good standards of housekeeping
- Complying with all health and safety requirements
- Managing the RealTime time and attendance information for reporting staff
