

VNA Driver (Warehouse Operative)

We have an exciting opportunity for a Very Narrow Aisle (VNA) Driver to join us in our warehouse. As VNA Driver, you will be responsible for a variety of warehouse duties according to operational needs.

Responsibilities

- A variety of warehouse duties under the guidance of the Warehouse supervisor according to the operational needs
- Working dual flexibility where needed at both Tilbrook and Kingston sites
- You may be required to work shifts as and when needed
- You may be required to wear a uniform which will be provided by the Company
- You will also be required to drive the Company van between our sites and to other destinations as and when needed
- Forward & Bulk picking/movement: make decisions within procedural guidelines or operate as directed and achieve a picking performance that ensures the service levels for customers are achieved (reduce errors made to a maximum error rate of 0.2%)
- Packing & despatch: make decisions within procedural guidelines or operate as directed and achieve a packing performance that ensures the service levels for customers are met (aim to achieve zero errors)
- Replenishment: make decisions within procedural guidelines or operate as directed and achieve a put away performance that ensures customers' orders can be picked within their service levels
- Goods-In: follow all established procedures to ensure all receipts are processed within eight hours
- Mechanical handling: if holder of appropriate licence, operate manual handling equipment in accordance with procedures and instructions. Operate safely in the workplace without endangering self or others. Report any and all accidents/dangerous occurrence immediately to a Supervisor or Manager and follow all procedures relating to the use of mechanical handling equipment
- Carry out general warehouse duties as directed: appropriate, timely and accurate action taken to meet standards set and service levels required

Health & Safety:

- Report all accidents/unsafe/unhealthy conditions to a Line Manager
- Work in accordance with any laid down systems
- Cooperate with Management to implement and maintain safe working practices and complete the assessments for Manual Handling regulations
- Operate safely in the workplace without endangering self or others

- Experience using a warehouse management system
- A VNA license or RTITB license is essential (we can pay for the successful candidate to attend a course to obtain this license)
